Color Walk FAQ

What is the color powder product made of?

The color powder is all certified non-toxic and free of any heavy metals. The bright colors are a combination of cornstarch, baking soda and FD&C (food-safe) dyes. It is FDA & OSHA approved.

Will the color powder affect my child's vision?

The color powder will not affect your child's eyes, however as a precaution we will be supplying every child with blue sunglasses to wear for the walk

Does the color powder wash out?

The powder washes out of clothing and is easily cleaned off skin. It's best to wear items that you wouldn't mind getting colorful. Hence why this years Walk-A-Thon shirts will be a light color! What better way to showcase the color that day?

What will the color process be that day?

There will be a set of volunteers that are **pre-trained** to aim in the air as the students pass by. (The colors will **NOT** be sprayed directly at the students) The powder will be sprayed out of spray bottles and there will be three colors sprayed over the course of the race.

Classes 1st grade and younger will be more limited in the amount of color sprayed that day.

What if I do not want my child to run through color?

We encourage all children to participate, however if in the case you feel uncomfortable, we will have two Walk-a-thon tracks available this year. All parents will be required to sign a parental release form for that day for their child to participate. The release will be sent home the first week of school. We take safety of our students seriously and this is meant to be a fun experience for all!
