Veterans' Day events at the MS, and promoting a dress down day in support of pancreatic cancer research and treatment (more info TBA) .

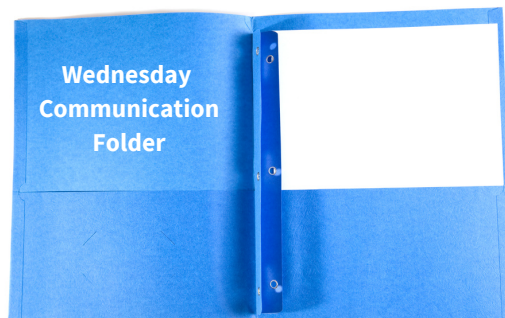

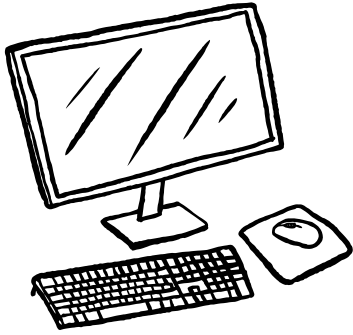

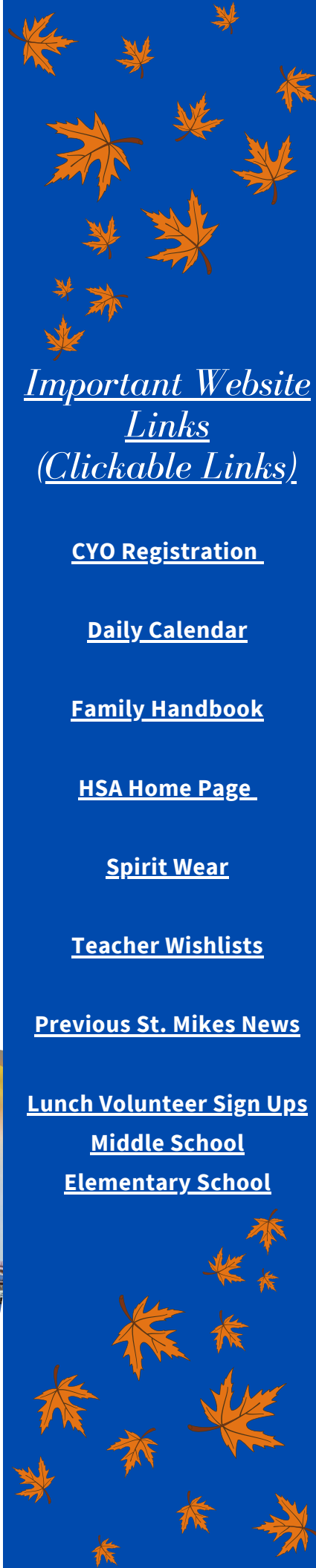

MIDDLE SCHOOL FAMILY VOLUNTEER NIGHT!

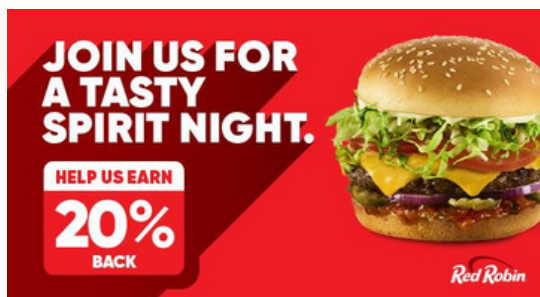
