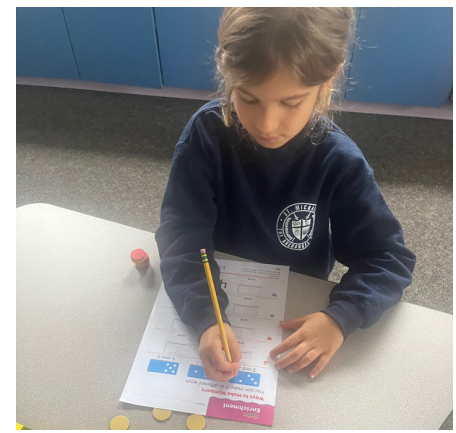
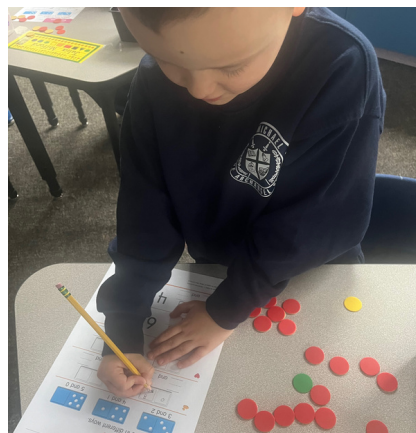


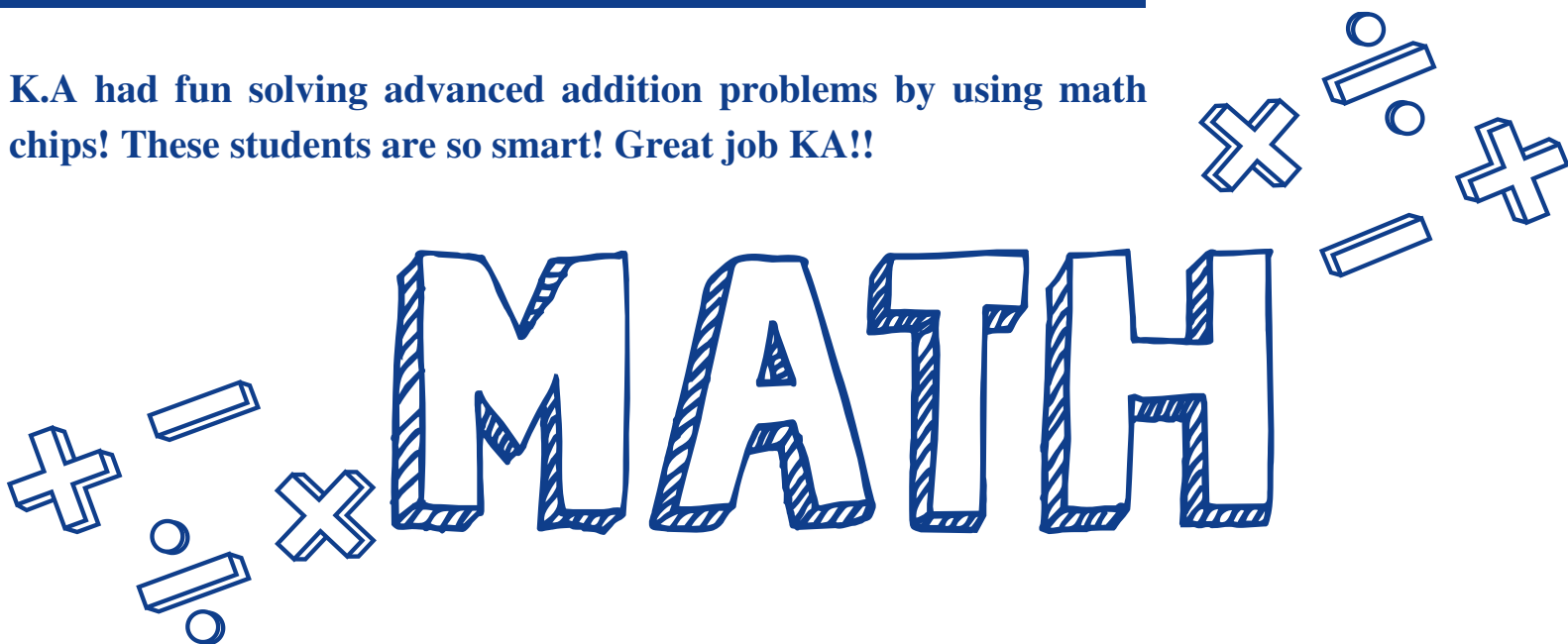

Uniform Changes!

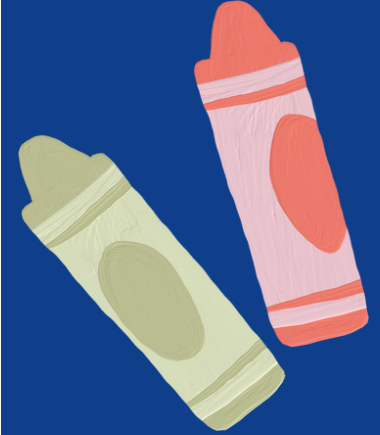


You asked, Mrs. Gano listened! Tired of washing white shirts over and over again and trying to get stains out? Well no more!

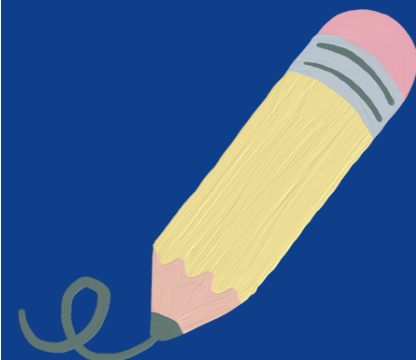
