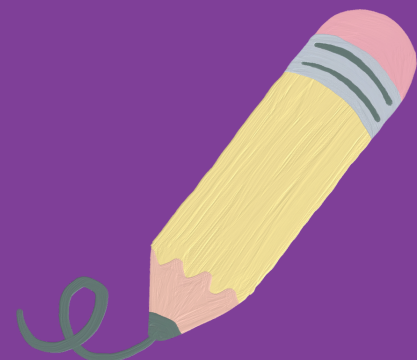

The Middle School students will have a fun afternoon with Gina Lewandowski and Allentown Central Catholic Alumni. Students will go through different stations and learn different soccer skills!

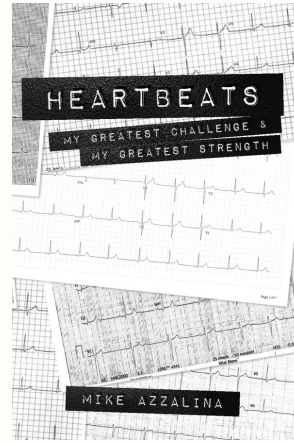


DINO DIG ASSEMBLY *1st & 2nd Grade Assembly* *Monday, February 26th*

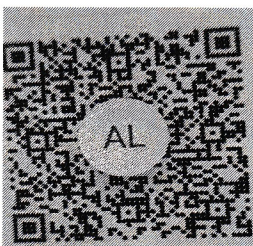
