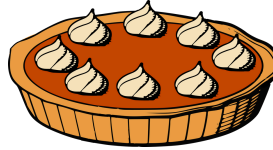
Jack will be attending Allentown Central Catholic in the Fall.

SCHOOL SECURITY GRANT AWARD

St. Mike's was awarded \$75,000 to make school security enhancements to both the ES & MS. It is the largest public grant that St. Mike's has ever won!

St. Mike's won the highly competitive grant from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. Only 6 non-public schools in all the Lehigh Valley were selected. St. Mike's won the maximum award amount.

Like all things at St. Mike's, it took a team effort.

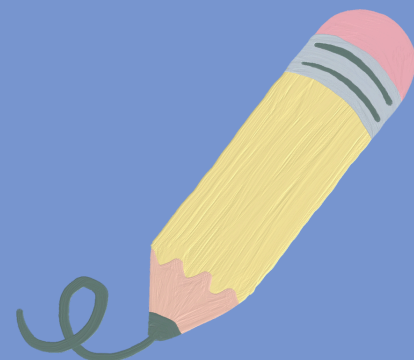

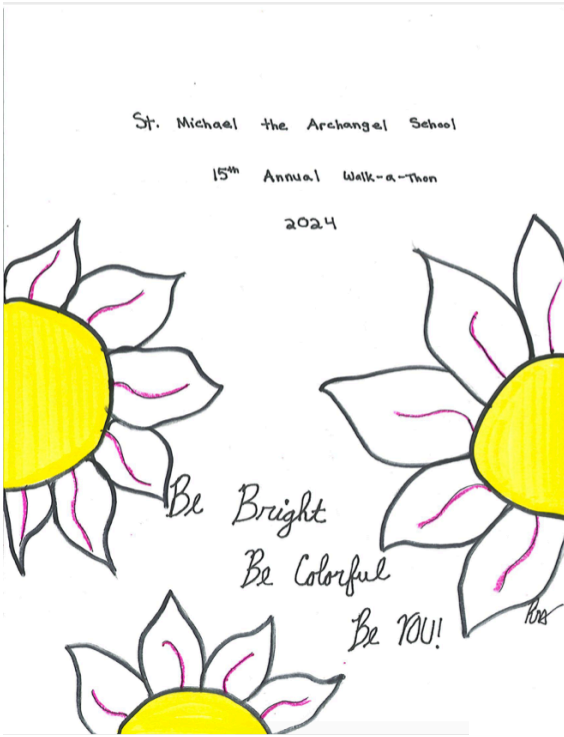
Vote on next years Walk-A-Thon T-Shirt
