CYO Coaches Clinics provide an overview of insurance requirements, sports medicine, coaching the child with special needs, and the integration of our Catholic faith and CYO.

All CYO coaches are required to attend a clinic within one year of starting to coach or they will be ineligible to continue until this requirement is fulfilled. Clinics are held several times a year to coincide with the various sports seasons.
