

Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope in Lent & in Life! Lenten Enrichment for Catholics

Jubilee: Special years in the Catholic Church the Pope proclaims to renew our lives as individuals & Church

Starting points about Jubilee Years in the Church:

- ♦ In Scripture:
 - o The Jubilee is based on the Hebrew concept of the jubilee year (Leviticus 25: 1-55) (No evidence exists that it ever happened in Jewish history as written, but in Jewish and Christian souls throughout the centuries YES it has and is happening again and again!)
 - o Isaiah prophesied that "a year of favor from the Lord (i.e., a jubilee) would happen with the coming of the Messiah (Isaiah 61: 1-11)
 - o Jesus proclaimed that a year of the Lord's favor was happening with his presence among them, saying, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." (Luke 4: 14-30) Wherever, whenever Jesus is present, we can proclaim jubilee!
- ◆ In 1300, Pope Boniface first established the tradition of celebrating a sacred jubilee in the Church as a time for individual and communal spiritual renewal in the Church.

<u>Principles of Jubilee</u>: "The Sovereign Lord has filled me with his Spirit..."

So... It begins with God's Spirit leading us!

- ◆ Theologians and scholars have pointed to 5 basic principles and practices connected with the Jubilee. They are: sabbath, justice, liberation, forgiveness and jubilation. Let's start with Sabbath:
- ◆ <u>Sabbath is:</u> placing God first, giving God time, by our words and actions showing our belief that we are more than what we do. First and foremost, we are beloved sons and daughters of God.
 - Leviticus 25: 1, 4: The Lord spoke to Moses on Mount Sinai, saying, "... in the 7th year there shall be a complete rest for the land, a sabbath for the Lord."
 - Jubilee: A time of R, R & R We are more than our work!
 - Rest for the land of our souls A "spiritual timeout" to restore our souls
 - Returning home To God, to who we are and whose we are; we are God's people, his BCoGs (Beloved Children of God).
 - Renewing hope We trust that God will provide!
