We invite all to participate in the traditional Lenten practices and activities below in a spirit of trust in God who promises new life at Easter. Our Lenten observances take on special meaning this year as we strive to connect them with the Jubilee principles of sabbath, forgiveness, justice, liberation, and jubilation.\*

#### Lenten Jubilee 2025 Activities at SMS

- + **Prayer:** participation at Mass, celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Stations of the Cross, learning and praying the Jesus Prayer, special classroom reflection activities
  - + Fasting: at the MS, sacrifice of the lunchtime snack cart along with encouragement of individual fasting activities that help us:
    - Remember that God is more important than anything or anyone
      Get rid of some bad habits that keep us from God
  - + **Almsgiving (doing good deeds)**: Along with your individual works of kindness and charity, our school community will engage in two works of charity:
  - World Mission project: donations to the Vincentian Fathers' carpentry school in Kenya. The project adds dormitories and kitchen space. The school trains homeless and those released from prison in carpentry skills to help them better their lives.
    - 2) Local project: Cops N' Kids Book Drive for children & community in the area More details for both to follow!

#### \*In the next newsletter, we'll look at how the Jubilee principles are at work in our Lenten Plan.


#### Stay tuned! For now, let's begin our BLE – Best Lent Ever!
